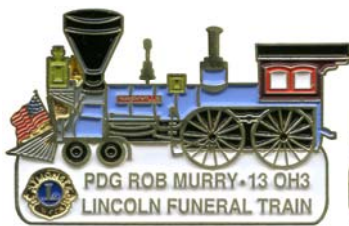

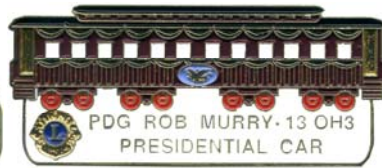

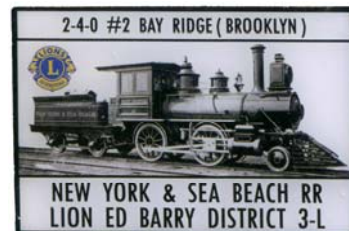

NOTE: The 4 pin Lincoln Funeral Train set is shown above FYI. On May 4, 1865, Lincoln's funeral services took place at Springfield's Oak Ridge Cemetery. Lincoln's Second Inaugural Address was read. A local choir sang traditional dirges and pieces composed for the occasion. Methodist Episcopal Bishop Matthew Simpson delivered an oration that left many in tears. The *Engine* shown above is the locomotive *Nashville*, which pulled the funeral train while traveling on the leg of the *Cleveland, Columbus and Cincinnati Railroad*. A portrait of President Lincoln hung over the cowcatcher with American flags posted on each side. The Tender Car shows the initials "C.C.&R.R." for the *Cleveland, Columbus, and Cincinnati Railroad*. Car #3 is the *Presidential Car*. Originally it was intended to be a lavish parlor car (a presidential office on wheels or 19th century version of Air Force One). In a tragic twist, Lincoln was fated to ride on it only in death. This is the car that carried the coffin containing the body of Lincoln's son, Willie, who had died of typhoid fever in 1862 at the age of 11 during Lincoln's second year in office. Car #4 carried high-ranking military personnel and members of the Lincoln family. Our thanks to PDG Rob Murry, Ohio, for this small bit of history associated with the funeral train.

## UTE PASS

In the fall and winter of 1886-87, the construction crews chiseled out a ledge in the Ute Pass. The tracks hugged the south side of the canyon, passing through eight tunnels carved from solid granite. Once an hour or so, there would be the heavy chuff of a train grinding up the pass. Passengers could look down and view the loaded freight wagons on the Ute Pass wagon road far below. The train would speed them on their way while the wagons would trudge along. Freight trains would work their way up and down the steel trail with heavy loads of equipment and supplies for the mining camps. The camps would send out heavily loaded cars and empties to the east. The Colorado Midland was an important link between the railroads in the west and those in the east. Shipments to or from Chicago, San Francisco, New York City or Portland were everyday occurrences on the Colorado Midland.
