The capital is Salt Lake City which is the home of the **Salt Lake City Lions Club** which, in 1921, was the first Lions Club in the State to be organized. He issued these pins at his own expense to insure all pin traders had these issues. All reissues have an extra long post on the reverse. This individual was the long time Pin Chairman for Utah and was responsible for the design and production of most of the UTAH Pins up until the time of his death.
