Pins that were reissued for 1968, 69, 70, 72 and 74 were issued by a Utah Lion who reportedly obtained permission from the then council. He issued these pins at his own expense to insure all pin traders had these issues. All reissues have an extra long post on the reverse. This individual was the long time Pin Chairman for Utah and was responsible for the design and production of most of the UTAH Pins up until the time of his death.




