


VIRGINIA is in the Mid-Atlantic region of the U.S.A. with a population in excess of 8,000,000. It was the 10th State admitted to the Union and was one of the original 13 Colonies. Lynchburg Host was the first Club organized in the State in 1921. Virginia has the distinction of having the first multiple district pin trading club organized in Lionism. The Capital City is Richmond.

1962 Cuff Links

These cuff links are rare. They were made for the sitting Governors in 1972. A Lion in Virginia who served as District Governor in 1958 -59 was a representative of Balfour Jewelry Co in Richmond, Va. This PDG was responsible for having the 1960 and 62 pins made. He was also responsible for the remakes. He had at least two sets of the 1962 pin made in 10K gold as well as at least two sets of the cuff links made in 10K gold






